DANCING. II: *Venus Reveng'd*, as 22 Dec. 1763.
COMMENT. Opera By Particular Desire.

DANCING. II: *A Dance of Slaves* by Lauchery, &c.; End of Play: *The Irish Lilt*, as 22 Sept. 1763.
COMMENT. Benefit for Mrs Davies. Oroonoko by Mr Powell (Hopkins). Very well (Hopkins Diary—MacMillan). Receipts: £166 10s. (MacMillan); charges: £64 4s. [Profit to Mrs Davies: £102 6s.]

COMMENT. Benefit for Miss Hallam. The Interlude By Desire. [The afterpiece again listed as for the last time this season.] Tickets deliver'd by Barrington will be taken.

DL THE ORPHAN OF CHINA. As 2 April, but Mandane – Mrs Hopkins, first time; Mirvan – Packer. *Epilogue* omitted. Also THE CHAPLET. Pastora – Mrs Dorman; Palamon – Fox; Damon – Vernon; Laura – Miss Young.
DANCING. *The Irish Lilt*, as 22 Sept. 1763.
COMMENT. Benefit for Mrs Scott. No building on Stage. Mrs Hopkins Mandane Mrs Yates being Ill (Hopkins). Benefit for Miss Young (playbill). Afterpiece: Not acted these two years. [See 10 Feb. 1762.] Charges: £64 4s. (MacMillan).
- CG THE JOVIAL CREW. As 11 Oct. 1763. Also HARLEQUIN SORCERER. As 20 Dec. 1763, but Harlequin – Woodward.
DANCING. II: *The Sicilian Peasants*, as 5 Oct. 1763.
