As 27 March, but Buck – Foote; Lucinda – Mrs Dyer; Song – Mrs Chambers. With the *Original Prologue*. Rest omitted.

 DANCING. I: *Hornpipe* by Cointe; III: *Fingalian Dance*, as 26 Nov. 1755; V: *Les Paisans Gallants*, as 3 Dec. 1755.
 SINGING. IV: *Ballad* by Roberts.
 COMMENT. Benefit for White, Treasurer. No Building on the stage. Afterpiece: By Desire, but for the last time this season. CG
- KING HENRY VIII. As 26 Dec. 1755. Also HARLEQUIN MOUNTEBANK. Principal characters: Rooker, Blakes, Leviez, Clough, Johnson, Vaughan, and Mrs Vernon, with Dances and Proper Decorations.
 COMMENT. Pantomime (stole from y^e Wells) for Saunderson Machinist went off well (Cross). Receipts: £140 (Cross). Tuesday 11
