 Serjeant – Phillimore; Soldiers – Chaplin, Alfred, &c. *DL*  
 COMMENT. Benefit for the Author [of mainpiece, who is named in the Account-  
 Book, but not on the playbill]. Receipts: £157 12s. (114/17; 40/10; 2/5; tickets:  
 none listed) (charge: £105).
- THE ROMAN FATHER.** As 3 Dec. 1787. Also **THE DUMB CAKE.** As *CG*  
 26 Dec. 1787.  
*SINGING.* As 3 Dec. 1787.  
 COMMENT. **THE PROVOK'D WIFE** [advertised on playbill of 31 Dec. 1787]  
 is obliged to be deferred on Account of Mrs Pope's Indisposition. Receipts: £137 7s.  
 (131/12; 5/15).
- THE SCHOOL FOR SCANDAL.** Sir Peter Teazle – King; Sir Oliver Surface – *Wednesday 2*  
 Aickin; Joseph Surface – R. Palmer; Sir Benjamin Backbite – Dodd; Crabtree – *DL*  
 Waldron; Rowley – Packer; Moses – Baddeley; Snake – Phillimore; Careless –  
 Barrymore; Trip – Lamash; Charles – Smith // Mrs Candour – Miss Pope; Maria –  
 Mrs Kemble; Lady Sneerwell – Mrs Ward; Lady Teazle – Miss Farren. Also

 Pope // Jacintha – Mrs Wells; Mrs Strickland – Mrs Bernard; Lucetta – Mrs Brown;  
 Millener – Miss Stuart; Clarinda – Mrs Abington. Also **THE DUMB CAKE.**

- PERCY.** As 29 Sept. 1787, but Percy – Barrymore // Elwina – Mrs Siddons. Also *Thursday 3*  
**HARLEQUIN JUNIOR.** As 26 Dec. 1787. *DL*  
 COMMENT. [In mainpiece the playbill retains Kemble, but he “did not act.  
 Barrymore . . . was his substitute for Percy” (*World*, 4 Jan.)] Receipts: £191 18s.

- IL RE TEODORO IN VENEZIA.** As 8 Dec. 1787. *King's*  
*DANCING.* End of Act I *Divertissement*, as 8 Dec. 1787, but omitted: Sga Bedini;  
 End of Opera *Les Offrandes à l'Amour*, as 8 Dec. 1787.  
 COMMENT. The Doors to be opened at 6:30. To begin precisely at 7:30  
 [same for rest of season]. Receipts: £92 3s. 6d. [non-subscription].
