COMMENT. [Afterpiece in place of THE MAID OF THE OAKS, advertised on playbill of 11 Sept. The dance, *The British Soldier Triumphant*, advertised on same, was not performed this night.]

HAY THE SON-IN-LAW. As 19 July. Also THE AUTHOR. As 23 June, but Printer's Devil – Barrett // Mrs Cadwallader – Mrs Barresford [i.e. formerly Mrs Bulkley]; omitted: Poet. Also THE AGREEABLE SURPRISE. As 13 June, but Laura – Mrs Plomer.
- Monday 15*
HAY INKLE AND YARICO. As 3 Sept., but Campley – Iliff; Trudge – Edwin Jun. Also A MOGUL TALE. As 3 July.
COMMENT. The last Night of the Season. [In mainpiece the playbill retains Edwin as Trudge, but "Young Edwin supplied the place of his father in the part of Trudge" (*London Chronicle*, 16 Sept.).]
